- Eligibility Criteria (Marks scored in English, 2<sup>nd</sup> Language (Hindi / Sanskrit / French / any other language, Mathematics, Science and Social Science)
  - $\circ~$  Group A: 85% and above in aggregate and 87% and above marks in Mathematics and Science.
  - Group B and C: 85% and above and 85% in Social Science and Mathematics (only if Mathematics is opted)
- Students who do not meet the eligibility criteria, or have already appeared for the admission test earlier, should not apply.
- Date of Test and Interaction: 6<sup>th</sup> June 2025, Reporting Time 8:30 AM
- Only shortlisted candidates will be intimated about the admission.

Please note that **English Core** is a compulsory subject. Subjects Options offered in class 11 other than English are as follows:

Subject Group A - Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Economics, Computer Science Subject Group B - Economics, Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies / Financial Markets Management (Skill Subject)

- Incomplete forms or ones without supporting documents/ illegible documents, will be rejected and will not be considered for registration. In this regard, no further communication will be entertained.
- Incorrect information, if any, found at any stage, will result in cancellation of the admission.
- Multiple forms will result in cancellation of all the forms.
- Selection will be based on performance in the Entrance Test and Interaction.
- Entrance test will be conducted on the School campus, based on class 10 syllabus, to be followed by an interaction. This will be held on Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2025 at 8:30 a.m.
- Test will be conducted as follows:
  - **Group A**: English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry. (3 hours duration)
  - **Group B**: English, Mathematics, Social Science (3 hours duration)
  - Group C: English, Social Science. (2 hours duration, however, if opted for Mathematics, the duration will be of 3 hours)
  - Syllabus to be tested: Class 10 CBSE curriculum
