Admission Notice for Class XI for Academic Session 2024 – 2025
16th May, 2024

Applications are invited for admission to class 11 (against a few vacant seats) for the academic session 2024-25. Only those students who have secured the minimum aggregate# in the board examination (marks scored in additional subject (if any) is not to be included) held in 2024 are eligible to apply. Due to the limited number of seats in class 11, the School Management reserves the right to offer admission only to meritorious applicants.

- **Dates for Registration: 17th- 21st May, 2024** (Online mode only)
- **#Eligibility Criteria – Minimum aggregate percentage:**
 - Group A: 90% and above
 - Group B and C : 85% and above
- **Date of Test and Interaction: 24th May, 2024, Reporting Time – 8:30 AM**
- **Only shortlisted candidates will be intimated about the admission.**

Please note that **English Core** is a compulsory subject. Subjects Options offered in class 11 other than English are as follows:

Subject Group A - Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology / Economics

Subject Group B - Economics, Mathematics, Accountancy, Business Studies / Financial Markets Management (Skill Subject)

Subject Group C - For customised subject options, select any one subject from each Group of 1 to 4:

 - Economics
 - Political Science
- **Group 2**
 - Mathematics
 - Information Technology (Skill Subject)
 - Psychology
- **Group 3**
 - History
 - Financial Markets Management (Skill Subject)
 - Legal Studies

 - Painting
- **Documents to be uploaded:**
 1. Recent passport size photographs of the candidate and both the parents
 2. Address Proof
 3. Class 10 marksheet (download or issued by CBSE / ICSE or other board)

- **Payment of Registration Fee:**

On successful completion of the process, a Registration Number will be generated and will be mailed to the e-mail address provided by the candidate in the Registration form. Registration fee of Rs. 25/- is to be paid online only, using one of the modes mentioned below:

1. Credit Card
2. Net Banking
3. Debit Card

IMPORTANT

- All NAMES (Candidate/ Father/ Mother) should be filled in expanded format and as per Class 10 Marksheet.
- Incomplete forms or ones without supporting documents/ illegible documents, will be rejected and will not be considered for registration. In this regard, no further communication will be entertained.
- Incorrect information, if any, found at any stage, will result in cancellation of the admission.
- Multiple forms will result in cancellation of all the forms.
- Selection will be based on performance in the Entrance Test and Interaction.
- Entrance test (offline mode), based on class 10 syllabus followed by an interaction will be held on **Friday, 24th May, 2024 at 8:30 a.m.**
- **Test to be conducted as follows:**
 - **Group A** : English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry. (3 hours duration).
(The candidates opting for Science with Biology will also appear for the test in Biology (total duration will be of 3½ hours)
 - **Group B**: English, Mathematics, Social Science (3 Hours duration)
 - **Group C** : English, Social Science. (2 hours duration, however, if opted for Mathematics, the duration will be of 3 hours)
 - Curriculum to be tested: **Class 10 CBSE curriculum**

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE APPLICANTS APPEARING FOR THE ADMISSION TEST:

1. Reporting Time for the Admission Test: **08:30 am, Entry from Gate 3, Sri Aurobindo Marg**
2. It is compulsory for each applicant to carry the following, which will be verified at the School Gate
 - A printout of Online Registration form submitted.
 - A valid Original Identity Card/Aadhaar Card/Passport.
 - Copy of Board Mark sheet (download from CBSE / ICSE or other board)

The candidate will not be allowed to sit for the test if the identity document is not found in order.

Any personal belongings other than those, which are mentioned above, such as Papers, Notebooks, Bags, Mobile phones, Watches and other Electronic Gadgets are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** in the examination room. School will not make any arrangements for keeping the applicants' belongings on the day of the examination.
